





During the 5 day program, men, women and youth categories were performed in Singles, Doubles and Teams formats. The results of Stroke and Fairway men and women team competition are as the following:



Hong Kong Woodball Association was founded in March 1999, the first Woodball invitation tournament was held along with the 42nd Festival of Sport—City Distilled Water Cup— at Hong Kong University of Science and Technology on 18 April 1999. It is the 58th Festival of Sport held in 2015, Woodball has become a sport event held every year since.

Hong Kong Open International Woodball Championship 2015 was held on 25-26 April at Hong Kong Institute of Education, there were 142 players representing 23 teams. 





Oman, Peru, Singapore, Thailand, Uganda, Vietnam, and Taiwangathered together for the last stop of International Woodball Tour of 2015.



Four Easy Core Strength Training on Woodball 4種簡易的核心肌群訓練應用於木球

Four benefits of core strength training to the swing of woodball

- ·Improved distance and consistence
- ·Greater efficiency of movement
- ·Improved body control and balance
- •Reduced risk of injury (the core muscles act as shock absorbers for jumps and rebounds etc.)

The core region consists of the abdominals, the hip musculature and the spine musculature. In fact core strength training aims to target all the muscles groups that stabilize the spine and pelvis. It's these muscle groups that are critical for the transfer of energy from large to small body parts during woodball long distance drive. From back swing to finish position a woodball swing takes between 1 and 2 seconds. In that time a woodball player's body generates some exceptional forces - potential energy that must be stored then released as efficiently as possible - and then you have to actually make contact with the woodball. The key to lengthening your shots is to increase the amount of force you can generate which in return, increases swing speed and mallet head speed.

The muscles of the trunk and torso act to stabilize the spine, pelvis and shoulder girdle. From this solid, balanced base the limbs can be moved powerfully and under control. Core strength training differs from many traditional weight training routines by working both the lower back and abdominals in unison. The same is true for the upper and lower body. All athletic movements incorporate the core in some way. Very few muscle groups are isolated. Instead the whole body works as a unit and core strength training endeavours to replicate this. Weak or poorly controlled core muscles have been associated with low back pain. The back muscles are responsible for movements such as extension and flexion of the spine and rotation of the trunk. Excessive or uneven shock on the spine may lead to back problems. This may be exaggerated because weak core muscles lead to improper positioning or a forward tilt. In many exercises that use the back muscles, the abdominal muscles contract isometrically stabilizing the body. The stronger and more correctly balanced the core muscles are, the less the uneven strain on the spine.



1. Prone Bridge (30 sec * 3 rep)

In a face down position, balance on the tips of your toes and elbows while attempting to maintain a straight line from heels to head. This exercise focuses on both the anterior and posterior muscle groups of the trunk and pelvis.



3. Supine Bridge (20 * 3 rep)

Lying on your back, raise your hips so that only your head, shoulders, and feet are touching the floor. The supine bridge focuses on the gluteal muscles. Stronger gluteals help maintain pelvic control.



2. Lateral Bridge (30 sec * 3 rep)

Start on your side and press up with your right arm. Form a bridge maintaining a straight line from your hand to your foot. Rest on your elbow to increase the difficulty. This exercise focuses on the abdominal obliques and transversus abdominus.



4. Pelvic Thrusts (20 * 3 rep)

Lie on your back with your legs bent 90 degrees at the hip. Slowly lift your hips off the floor and towards the ceiling. Lower your hips to the floor and repeat for the prescribed number of repetitions.



Study of Metabolic Syndrome Factors and Geriatric Depression Tendency According to the Woodball Careers

ABSTRACT

Introduction: The purpose of this study is to compare the differences in the metabolic syndrome factors and the tendencies of geriatric depression among woodball players with various experience of the game.

Methods: Sixty experienced woodball players participated in this study. They were classified in three groups, which were G1(< 3years careers: n=24), G2(4~8year careers: n=18) and G3(<10 years careers: n=18). The following metabolic syndrome factors were measured; Blood pressure, blood glucose, waist circumference and percentage of fat. A GDS(Geriatric Depression Scale) questionnaire was self –written to measure the depression tendency. Experimental data was analyzed by one-way ANOVA to measure the significance between the groups.

Results: We found a significant difference between groups for the waist circumference(p<.01). Blood glucose was shown between G1 and G2(p<.05). Blood pressure was significantly shown in G1 compared with G3(p<.05). The depression scale showed no significance between the groups. But G1 had more tendency compared with G2 and G3.

Conclusions: Continuous and regular woodball activity may be one of the reasons for the healthier life of the career group, when compared with the beginner group. The three groups are all free of geriatric depression. This data suggests that long-term and regular physical activity, through pursuing woodball activities, will have a positive effect on the healthy life of an older person.



CONCLUSION

In this study, the metabolic-syndrome risk factors of people who regularly play wood ball, and their depression degrees, were investigated based on their careers, to verify the influence of the continuous playing of wood ball on health management. The subjects, consisting of 60 wood ball players, were divided into three groups depending on their careers: group 1 (with one- to three-year careers), group 2 (with four- to nine-year careers), and group 3 (with over-10-year careers). All the three groups maintained good health conditions, but some results in certain items circled the reference value or tended to show differences between the groups. First, group 3 showed a higher systolic blood pressure value than the reference value, but no differences were observed among the groups. Second, all the three groups presented higher blood sugar levels. Particularly, group 2 presented statistically higher values compared with the other groups (p<.05). Third, all the groups showed normal abdominal-girth levels, but group 2 presented statistically higher values than the other groups (p<.01). Lastly, all the three groups showed healthy conditions in the geriatric depression tendency test using GDS. As all the groups did not show more than three risk factors of metabolic syndrome, their risk of metabolic syndrome was confirmed to be low.

In conclusion, the predictive factors of metabolic syndrome in elderly people who regularly and consistently played wood ball remained in a healthy state, and such people's mental health status appeared considerably favorable. In the future, follow-up studies should be conducted using diverse research approaches.
