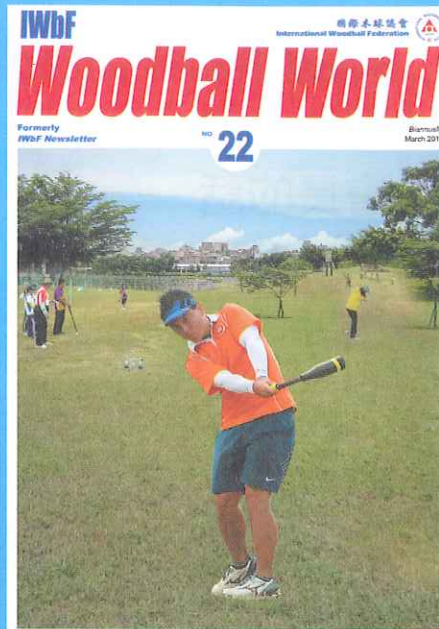

2014年除了各國舉辦的國際木球公開賽外，另有三場錦標賽即9月在中國三亞舉辦第六屆世界盃木球錦標賽，10月在馬來西亞玻璃市舉辦的第四屆世界大學木球錦標賽及11月在泰國普吉島舉辦的第四屆亞洲沙灘運動會(沙灘木球項目)。

國際木球總會原本規劃單數年辦亞洲盃和亞洲大學的比賽，雙數年辦世界盃和世界大學的比賽，但從2008年在印尼峇里島舉辦亞洲沙灘運動會後，雙數年增加了沙灘木球競賽。今年比較特別的是三場大比賽不只地點集中在亞洲，比賽時間更是連續9、

10、11三個月。參加這三場比賽是國際木總會會員國的權利也是義務，因此在三個月內參加三場大型比賽難免會給各會員國及選手帶來困擾，所以各國木球協會都應及早安排參賽事宜。

隨著木球運動的發展，木球參與大型比賽和國際性運動會的機會會再增加，為我們木球選手提供更大更多的競技舞台，這是產生木球明星的必備條件，也是我們木球運動更上一層樓的必備條件。因此合作辦好三大比賽是我們各國木球朋友目前最重要的重點工作。

President's Message

Co-run 3 Major Events – Bring up Star Players

In the year 2014, apart from the open championships hosted by IWbF members, we will also be having the 6th World Cup Woodball Championship in Sanya, China in September, the 4th World University Woodball Championship in Perlis, Malaysia in October, and the 4th Asian Beach Games (Woodball Discipline) in Phuket, Thailand in November.

At the outset, International Woodball Federation planned to organize Asian Cup Woodball Championship and Asian University Woodball Championship in odd-numbered years, while World Cup Woodball Championship and World University

Woodball Championship in even-numbered years. However, since the 1st Asian Beach Games held in Bali, Indonesia in year 2008 has included Woodball Discipline. Therefore, even-numbered years' big events comprise this biennially Asian Beach Games.

Specifically in the year 2014, not only the hosting cities of the 3 major events mentioned above implode to be held in Asia Countries, but will also going to be held continuously in the month of September, October, and November. Taking part in these 3 events is the right and obligations of the members of IWbF, thus, all Woodball associations should make

early arrangements due to the inconvenience which may be caused by the above events.

In pace with the development of Woodball sport, the opportunity for Woodball to participate in international games and major championships will increase, consequently provides Woodball players a greater and bigger competitive platform. In addition, it is the prerequisites for starting up Woodball star players and Woodball to seek for a higher level of development. Therefore, co-run the 3 major events is the most important priority for all IWbF members.

China (Fenghua) International Woodball Open Tournament 2013 & Intercollegiate Strait Cup Woodball Invitational Open 2013 – Fruitful Results

China (Fenghua) International Woodball Open Tournament 2013 was hosted in Yinfeng Village, Xikou Town, Fenghua City, the 20th century Chinese political and military leader - Mr. Chiang Kai-Shek's hometown, on 3 – 8 September 2013 by Leisure Sports Administrative Center of the China General Administration of Sport, Chinese Woodball Association, and Fenghua City Government.

The total of 21 teams, almost 200 players participated in the tournament which located at the golf course of 5-star Yinfeng Holiday Resort of Xikou. It is also located between Siming Mountain and Yan River where the landmark of Fenghua City is. Besides, the city is not only remarkable, but also have outstanding people. Many people come to the place for playing Woodball and also appreciate the scenery.

1. International Woodball Open Tournament

The Group Event ranking was summed up by the results of Single Stroke Competition. Players from

preliminary would be eligible to play in the final and the final result would start from new games without summing up by preliminary. The Organizing Committee arranged a top player to compete another top player during the final, which add the exciting of the game. At the finals, each player considered every hitting carefully. After 3 days fierce battles, the result came out and the competition completed successfully.

2. Intercollegiate Strait Cup Woodball Invitational Open

After Intercollegiate Strait Cup Woodball Invitational Open finished, the OC organized a skills exchanging and resources sharing activity. Mr. Yung-Pin LI, the coach of Chinese Taipei team, explained the skill and movement of full swing. Ms. NG Lai Ling, the coach of Hong Kong team, illustrated the trick of gating and approach. As the Chief Referee of the game, I instructed Woodball gating skill for gate areas as well as rules. They teach Woodball over a decade. They have many outstanding champion students. Through this skill exchanging and resources sharing activity, players

opened their eyes and learned the skills out from books. The coaches got big applause during their instructions.

3. Funny Game

Since the competition was closed to the Moon Festival, the OC arranged a game named "The Jade Hare Hold the Moon". Every participant, even coach, do what ever they can to goal points and win the Moon cake. Everyone had a lot of fun and seemed unwilling to leave.

4. Wide sweeping view and joyful gathering

According to the quote from The Analects from Confucius, "It is so great when friends visit from distant place". Therefore, the OC provided a wonderful local visiting and Fenghua City Government covered the expenses of traffic and tour for participants. They were very happy and impressive for visiting 5A grade scenic spot. Hope we would have more international championships in Fenghua City in the future in order to have a joyful Woodball reunion.

3rd Uganda Open International Woodball Championship 2013

The Uganda Woodball Federation had the pleasure of organizing two events – the 3rd Uganda Open International Woodball Championship and the UWbF Coaching Workshop between the dates of October 09 and 12, 2013. Coinciding with the celebrations for the 51st Independence Day for Uganda, we were glad to have Prof. Nick Huang and Ms. Shu-Han Lu as our foreign competitors and facilitators for the coaching workshop.

The competition and workshop were held at Makerere University Business School and the fairways were set out in the university's green parks. The differing landscapes and slopes made both the competition and the Coaching exam challenging. The UWbF Coaching workshop was conducted for two days (October 10 & 11) and was attended by 40 participants mostly games teachers and former Woodball players. A practical exam was conducted on the second day to test the participants' understanding of the basics of the game.

Both events were covered Mr. Mitsumasa Fukumoto from NHK Japan Broadcasting Corporation. In addition, Mr. Fukumoto made a

In preparation for the competition, Prof. Nick Huang conducted special training sessions for Ndejje University and Motherwell Junior School – Mutungo. Ndejje University went ahead to emerge winners of the Open event and Motherwell Junior School were runners-up in the Youth category.

Besides the competition and the coaching workshop, Prof. Nick and Ms. Shu-Han visited Ndejje University where the IWbF donated equipment production machines are housed. This is primed as the center

of Woodball equipment production on the African continent.

Our next course of action shall base on the activities of October 9 - 12, 2013. The Youth will be targeted in school, to develop Woodball players from an early stage. The 29 UWbF certified Grade I Coaches will help in talent identification, nurturing and development of players in both the youth and open categories of players. The equipment production project will enable us spearhead Woodball development on the African continent.

We hope that the 4th edition of this prestigious annual event will attract more international teams. We will be happy to meet and welcome you to Uganda.

Uganda Coaching Workshop

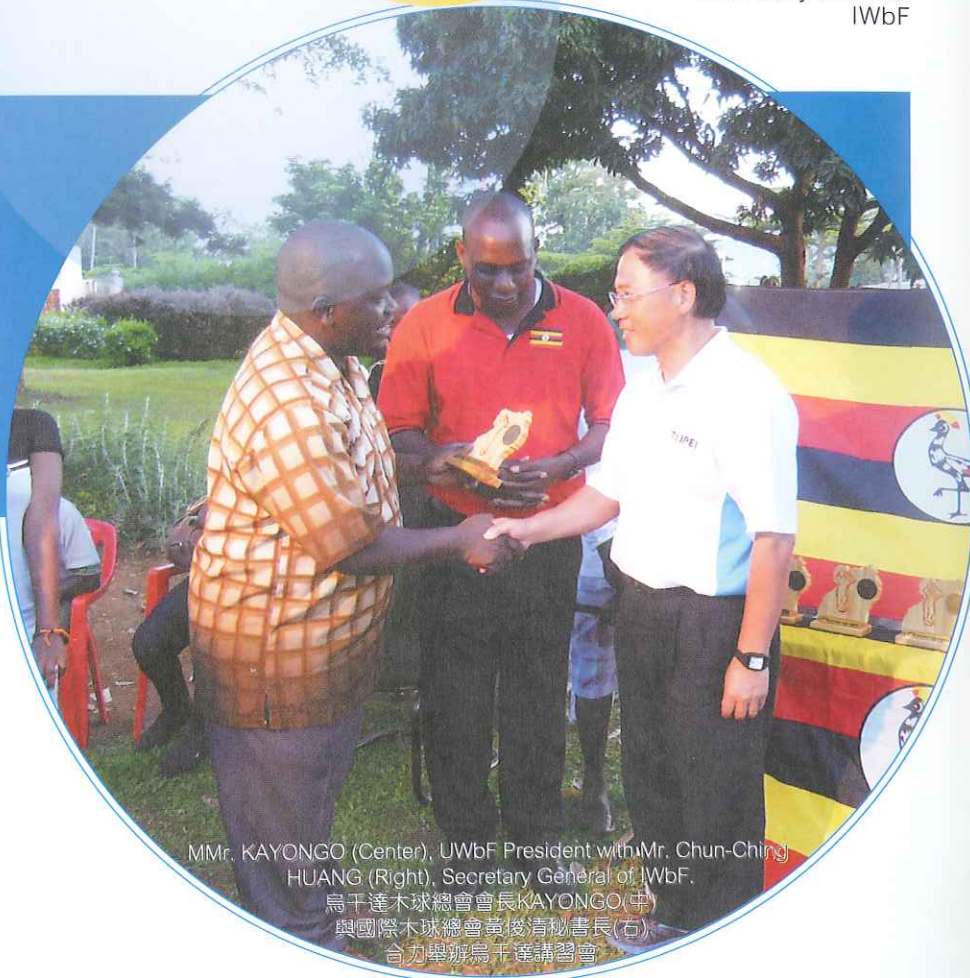

On Jan. 8, Woodball Association of International Woodball Coaching Workshop was hosted by IWbF and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Taiwan. I was honored to be invited to be the lecturer of Uganda Woodball Federation Coaching Workshop. Meanwhile, this was also my second time visiting Uganda. (My first time was to attend East Africa University Games 2009.) Before I came to Uganda, I have seen a Uganda female player who has made great progress with her performance in Malaysia Open International Woodball Championship. According to her good result, she was already as good as female players from Taiwan. The workshop was rounded off with active participation from students. I was deeply touched by the desire I saw in the student's eyes.

During my visit to Uganda, I also participated in the Uganda International Open Woodball Championship. The advance and progress of Uganda players gave me a deep impression, especially the stability of long-distance strike and gating strategy. They have reached the same level as Asian players. 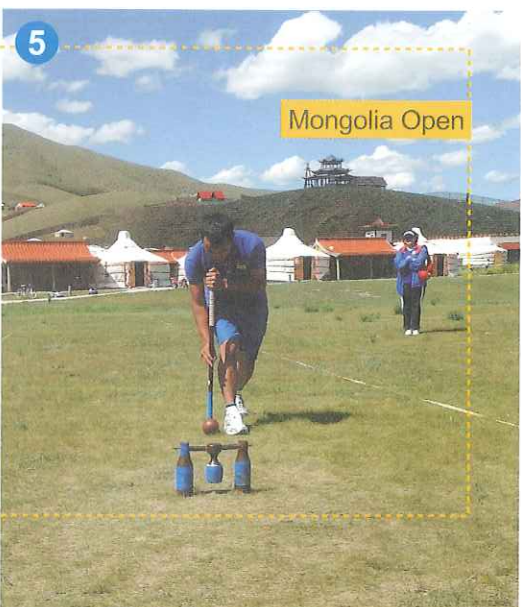

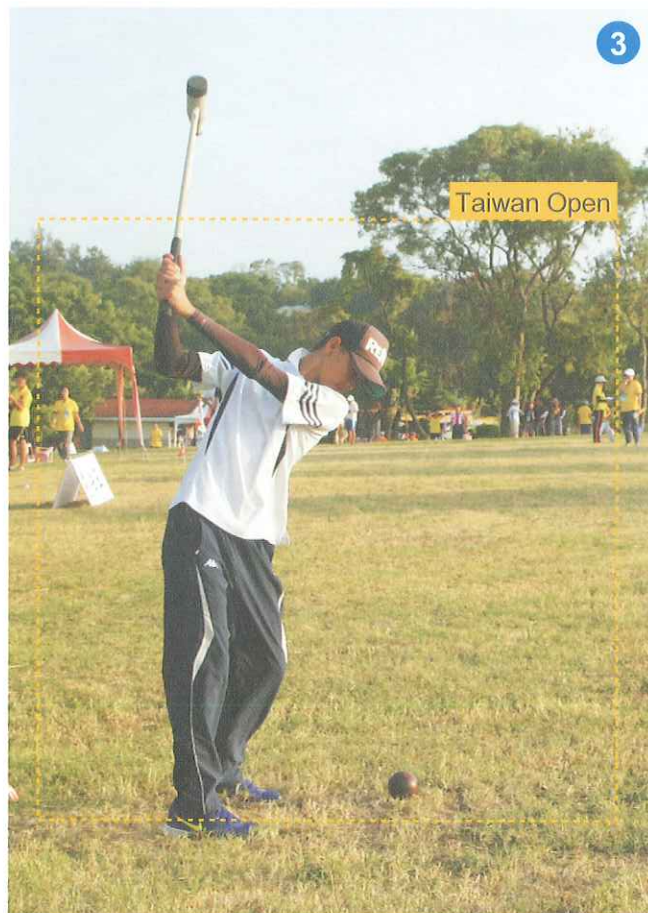

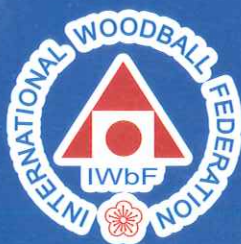
