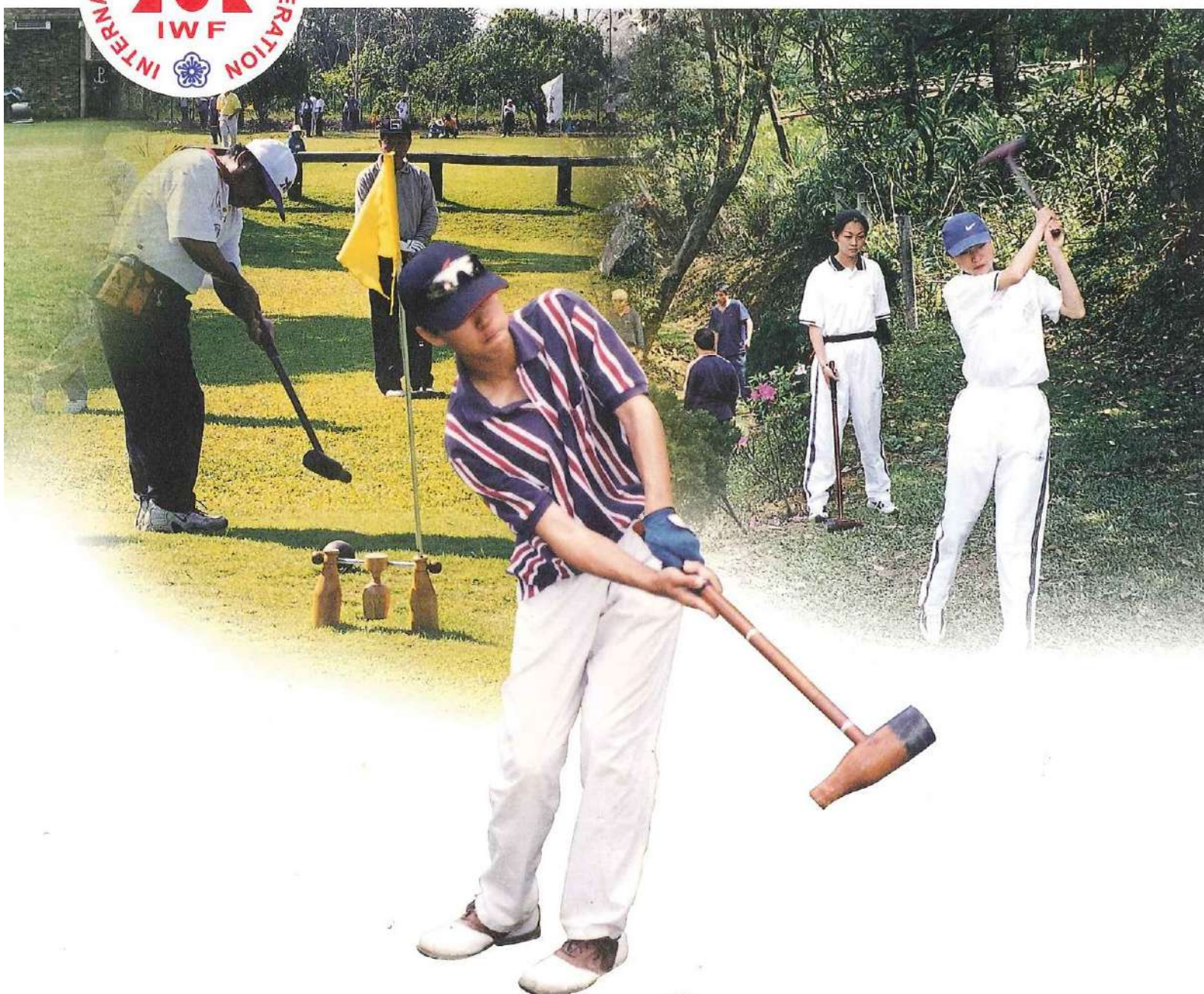

## THE LATEST INFORMATION OF WOODBALL ACTIVITIES

1. The 5th Malaysian Woodball International Championships, August 24-30 2001, will have Japan, Singapore, Hong Kong, Chinese Taipei, Thailand, Malaysia to participate, totally 30 people.

2. Mainland China Physical Education Bureau, Social Physical Education Center, is going to hold the Woodball Coach/Referee Workshop on November 6 to 11, 2001, Ningpo City. They will also hold the provincial associate meeting to cultivate staffs for improving the quality of Woodball popularization.

3. Chinese Taipei is going to hold the Chungcheng Cup Woodball Championships on October 20 to 21, 2001, Chiayi City.

4. Singapore Woodball Association is going to hold the 2nd Singapore Woodball Championships on December 6 to 8, 2001.

5. AUSF is going to popularize Woodball Sport again in the 3rd Ex-co meeting on August 25, 2001, Beijing University of Physical Education.

6. IWF will introduce Woodball sport in the Athlete Village during the FISU Executive Committee meeting and General Assembly on August 19 to 21, 2001. We will send a Woodball set for those who especially interested in this sport.

7. Woodball Sport has already been approved by Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation (CTUSF) as a formal event in 2002 Chinese Taipei Intercollegiate Athletic Meet.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS:

a. The general rules of the International Woodball Federation 2001 will be adopted.

### b. Regulations

1. Every individual/team player will take turns to hit the ball in two standard Woodball courses, which totally consist of 24 fairways.

The best 4 players' lowest score will form the team result. Finalist (the first twelve players) in individual competition (male and female) will play in the final 3rd Woodball course. Whoever scores the least strokes in total 36 fairways is the winner in individual competition.

2. The team consists of four to five players, those who are required to finished their games in 24 fairways. Within the team, only four players' scores, which are added up to the least, will be counted. If there are less than four players in the team, their scores will be counted into as individual scores.

3. Every player plays in individual competition but he/she can be a member of only one team.

4. In case that there are two teams which achieve the same scores, the winner will be decided by the least stroke which happens in one of the two teams playing in chosen fairway.

The 1st European Woodball Championships and the 2nd International Woodball Invitation Championships had already accomplished successfully during 2001 July 18 to 20 in Graz, Austria. The participating countries were Austria (AUT), Croatia (CRO), Estonia (EST), Finland (FIN), France (FRA), Germany (GER), Italy (ITA), Poland (POL), Sweden (SWE), United Arab Emirates (UAE), and Chinese Taipei (TPE), totally 11 countries, 87 players.

Through the keen competition of two days, the Chinese Taipei team is the most outstanding in the sult. Our players received not only much praise and admiration for their excellent skills from the European players, but also we were placed as the learning models by them.

From this results above, Chinese Taipei (TPE), which is the inventing country of Woodball, almost won the games overall. However, we firmly believe that once the Woodball sport is popularized in Europe, the European Woodball players can perform as well as Asian Woodball players and compete with one another.

At present, the Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation and the International Woodball Federation are enthusiastically preparing to host the 2002 World University Woodball Championships in Taipei. We already have 19 countries that want to organize their national teams to participate in FISU University Woodball Championships. President of FISU, Dr. George E. Killian, promised that the time 14 countries send their college students to join the competition, the 1st 2002 World University Woodball Championships will certainly be held. We are very glad that this dream is eventually going to come true, and we cordially welcome all our friends in every country who love Woodball to Taiwan.
