We have the honour to invite you and your university athletes to participate in the 5th World University Woodball Championship which will be held in Taipei, Chinese Taipei from October 21 to October 26, 2016.

Provisional Programme

The 5th World University Woodball Championship will take place in National Taipei University of Nursing and Health Science in Taipei and general programme is as following:

19-20 October	Arrival and accreditation
21 October	Head of delegation meeting / Opening ceremony
22-25 October	Competition
26 October	Finals / Awarding and Closing Ceremony
27 October	Departure

Technical Rules

FISU regulations

40. WOODBALL

40.1 GENERAL TERMS

The Woodball competitions shall be run in accordance with the most recent technical rules of the International Woodball Federation (IWbF), unless otherwise stated. In the events of a disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by the Executive Committee in agreement with the Organising Committee and the CTI. The competitions shall last six (6) days and include the following events:

- Stroke competition
- Fairways competition

Each country may enter a maximum of seventeen (17) people: twelve (12) competitors (six (6) men and six (6) women) and five (5) officials.

In each event, each country may enter:

Stroke competition

Men:

- Individual event: six (6) competitors;
- Team event: six (6) competitors.

Women:

- Individual event: six (6) competitors;
- Team event: six (6) competitors.

Fairway competition*:

- Four (4) singles: Men's / Women's (2 each)
- Two (2) pairs: men's doubles
- Two (2) pairs: women's doubles
- Two (2) pairs: mixed doubles

***In Fairway competition, each player may enter a maximum of 2 events.**

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

40.2 PRE-COMPETITION PROCEDURE

Three (3) months before the Championship, the Organising Committee has the right to collect 25% of the total cost of stay per athlete and official from participating countries.

40.2.1 Drawing method

1. No more than four (4) athletes in one (1) flight;
2. No more than one (1) athlete from the same country in a flight.

40.2.2 Method

1. All countries and athletes shall be assigned a number
 - A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, A6
 - B1, B2, B3, B4, B5, B6 ...
2. The flights shall be drawn as below:
 - A1, B1, C1, D1
 - E1, F1, G1, A2
 - B2, C2, D2, E2
 - F2, G2, A3, B3 ...

The flights shall be drawn at least one (1) day before an event.

40.3.1 Nomination

Referees shall be appointed jointly by IWbF and the FISU Technical Delegate. The participating delegations shall bear their costs of travel, board and lodging in proportion to the number of athletes registered (from two (2) days before the opening ceremony to one (1) day after the closing ceremony).

Other costs are referenced in the FISU – IWbF partnership agreement.

The Organising Committee shall announce the exact sum shortly after the closing date for nominative entries (one (1) month before the beginning of the World University Championship).

40.3.2 Number of technical officials needed and qualification

a) Chief referee

One (1) chief referee who shall have the qualification or international licence of IWbF and experience in serving as a referee in international competitions for at least ten years.

b) Referees

A total of twelve (12) referees is required to officiate at the twelve (12) fairways; these referees shall have the qualification or international licence of IWbF.

c) Linesmen

A total of twelve (12) linesmen is required to assist the referees at the fairways; these linesmen shall have good knowledge of Woodball.

d) Technical workshop

A technical workshop, to be conducted by the chief referee, shall be held at least one (1) day before the competition starts; all referees and linesmen shall attend this workshop.

Eligibility

According to FISU regulations, only the competitors who satisfy the following conditions may take part in this championship:

a) be a citizen of the nation (region) he/she represents;

b) be born between January 1st, 1988 and December 31st, 1998.

c) be a student who is currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of his/her country (region);

d) be a former student of an institution mentioned in (c) who has obtained the academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

Doping Control

Doping control will be conducted in compliance with the regulations laid down by the International University Sports Federation (FISU) and under the WADA.

Deadlines for Entries

General Entries (engagement of participation)	April 21st, 2016
Quantitative Entries (number of participants)	July 21st, 2016
Payment of Deposit (25%)	July 21st, 2016
Nominative Entries (names of participants)	September 21st, 2016

All the entries must be registered via the online system provided by FISU as of www.wuc.in-1.it. For any assistance or query the participating delegations may have, it is advised to contact the system provider via support@in-1.it.

Financial Conditions

a. FISU Registration Fee:

- effective member-associations of FISU: **20 Euros** per competitor and official;
- other association: **40 Euros** per competitor and official

b. Participation Fee:

70 Euros per person per day paid to the Organizing Committee by each participating country.



Deposit

All participating countries are requested to pay the deposit of 25% of participation fees for each athlete and official by **July 31st, 2016 to the following account of O.C.** , and upon their arrival, pay to the Organizing Committee the remaining balance:

Accommodations and Transportation

A nearby cozy Hotel will be designated by the organizing committee to accommodate not only officials/athletes but also FISU CISCA delegates. Hotel information will be available soon on the website of this event.

As to the transportation, the organizing committee will take care of the local transportation between Taoyuan International Airport (airport code: TPE) and the hotel. For training and competition sessions, shuttle bus service is provided between the hotel and the competition venue.

Visa

Countries eligible for Visa-exempt entry

1. The nationals of the following countries are eligible for the visa exemption programme, which permits a duration of stay up to 90 days:

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, U.K., and Vatican City State.

2. The nationals of the following countries are eligible for the visa exemption programme, which permits a duration of stay up to 30 days :

Australia, Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Singapore and USA

Requirements: Those who are eligible for visa exemption programme must have his/her passport with validity of at least six months upon entry, except for Japanese passport holders with validity of more than 3 months who are eligible for visa-exempt entry. In addition, confirmed return air ticket is also necessary when checked in immigration.

Those who are not listed above, please follow the application procedure for the entry visa as soon as possible. We strongly advise you to submit the visa application as soon as possible as some applications requires more time. Should you have any query or need any assistance, please do not hesitate to contact the O.C.
